General Surgery— **Endoscopy of Colon (Colonoscopy or Flexible Sigmoidoscopy)**

Introduction

You are awaiting a date for your endoscopy. This procedure can be done with sedation and/or with inhalational analgesia (pain relieving gas), sometimes patients don't need any pain relief. You will receive bowel preparation in advance of your procedure.

Your procedure will be done as a day case in the Endoscopy Department, so you will not need to stay in hospital overnight.
