

Vascular Surgery – First Outpatient

Introduction

You have been referred for an appointment to the Vascular Service, the service provides treatment for patients with the following conditions;

Peripheral Vascular disease of the upper/lower limb, abdominal aortic aneurysm, peripheral aneurysm, intermittent claudication, ischaemic limb, critical limb ischaemia, rest pain, gangrene, leg ulcers, thoracic outlet syndrome, Raynauds Disease, diabetic vascular disease, Palmar hyperhidrosis, symptomatic varicose veins, varicose veins with skin changes, varicose veins with thrombophlebitis.

We are working hard to reduce the backlog of patients waiting for an appointment in this service and you will receive an appointment as soon as possible based on the clinical urgency of your referral.
